A WALK FOR WILDLIFE AND WATER**



Come along for an interactive walking tour, with talks from experts, showing what we are set to lose to HS2. The walk will cover habitats that are home to endangered eels, bats, otters, water voles and the chalk aquifer that provides much of London's water, in an area set to lose 28,000 trees to HS2. The walk is 5km and will leave at 12.15pm from Denham Station (20mins from Marylebone, or 20mins from Uxbridge by bus 331). Please wear boots.

There is also the option to meet at the water pumping station (UB9 6PE) at 3pm. The event ends at 4pm at the Bear On The Barge pub (UB9 6PE). It's a 15 minute walk back to the station from the pub.

Please bring a ribbon to tie, or a decoration to hang. Please use public transport wherever possible. Limited parking.
